COURSE NOTES

- Note 1:* New or Revised Course - see description for detailed information.
- Note 2:* Limited enrollment offering; may be dropped only during the limited Add/Drop period.
- Note 3:* Required for graduation. Professional Responsibility must be taken during second year.
- Note 4:* Total of 3 hours of credit; may register for either 2 hours Fall and 1 hour Spring or 1 hour Fall and 2 hours Spring; must enroll both semesters.
- Note 5:* This is a one semester clinic. Students will receive 6 credits, not to exceed a total of 20 clinic or externship credits, excluding the externship seminar credits.
- Note 6:* 2 hours Fall, 2 hours Spring; must enroll both semesters. This is a no drop course offering. Students will receive grade at end of each semester.
- Note 7:* Senior editors may earn three credits (2 hours in Fall and 1 hour in Spring or 1 hour in Fall and 2 hours in Spring); other third year student editors may earn two credits by registering for 1 hour each semester or two hours in either the Fall or Spring semester.
- Note 8:* Third-year students who are eligible to receive 2 hours of credit for academic year may register for 1 hour of credit each semester or 2 hours of credit in either Fall or Spring.
- Note 9:* Students eligible to receive 2 hours of credit for academic year may register for 1 hour fall, 1 hour spring; must register both semesters.
- Note 10:* 3 hours Fall, 3 hours Spring, must enroll both semesters; will receive grade at the end of academic year
- Note 11:* All Associate Moot Court Board members must register for a section of Trial Practice in Spring Semester.
- Note 12:* Does not meet writing requirement.
- Note 13:* The seven directors only will receive 2 credits.
- Note 14:* International Law is required for members of the Journal of International Law and Commerce.
- Note 15:* Cross-listed with Whitman School of Management. Classes will meet for 8 weeks on the following days: 1/19, 1/26, 2/2, 2/9, 2/16, 2/23, 3/2 and 3/9.
- Note 16:* Will meet at an off-campus location at the law offices of Green & Reid, 113 Intrepid Lane, Syracuse.
- Note 17:* 6 hours Fall, 6 hours Spring; must enroll both semesters unless special permission is obtained from instructor.
- Note 18:* No-drop limited enrollment offering. Students are not permitted to drop course at any time after the last day of the Fall or Spring registration period.
- Note 19:* Course may be taken with the Pass/Fail grading option. See Academic Rule J(3-5).
- Note 20:* 3 Ls who serve as editors will earn 2 credit hours by registering for 1 hour in each semester or 2 hours in either Fall or Spring. All other 3L members will earn 1 credit hour for the academic year.
- Note 21:* Graded Pass/Fail only.
- Note 22:* Tentative course offering and is subject to cancellation.
- Note 23:* Course designated to meet writing requirement.
- Note 24:* If enrollment is more than 16 students, the course will not be offered as a seminar although students may register for an additional credit to satisfy the COL writing requirement.
- Note 25:* Enrollment in Lawyer as Negotiator requires permission of instructor; special registration procedures apply. This is a NO-DROP course offering and may not be dropped at anytime without permission from the instructor.
- Note 26:* Emphasis on Supreme Court practice in New York.
- Note 27:* Required course for JD/MPA students. Cross-listed with PPA 751.
- Note 28:* Additional case review time will be required.
- Note 29:* Cross listed with SUNY Environmental Science and Forestry (FOR 689) and taught by SUNY/ESF Professor Robert W. Malmshemer. Law students are to enroll using LAW 865 and will receive law credits accordingly.
- Note 30:* Course will be limited to 20 law students and 15 medical and graduate students; cross-listed with SUNY School of Medicine, CCFM 1404. Does not meet the writing requirement.
- Note 31:* Pre-requisites or co-requisites include Corporations or Agency/Partnership. Suggested prerequisites include Commercial Transactions, Intellectual Property or International Business Transactions.
- Note 32:* Students may register for up to 20 credits in clinics and externships, excluding the externship seminar.
- Note 33:* One semester seminar or Research Center or Special Programs course.
- Note 34:* This is an interdisciplinary course cross listed with SUNY/ESF, Maxwell and Geology.
- Note 35:* Students may earn two hours of fully graded credit for independent research under faculty supervision. Satisfactory completion of a two credit independent research project may satisfy the writing requirement for graduation provided that the project satisfies the requirements of Academic Rule A(3)(b).
- Note 36:* Students who earn 2 credits may register for 2 credits in either the Fall or Spring Semester or 1 credit hour each semester for a total of 2 credits. Students who earn 1 credit may register for 1 credit hour either in the Fall or Spring.
- Note 37:* Course is exempt from upper class grading curve.
- Note 38:* This is a limited enrollment offering. Enrollment priority will be given to students who participated in the National Security Law Counter-Terrorism Independent Research in the fall semester. The class will meet in the Research Center, Room 287; meeting day/time will be arranged by Professor Banks. Pre/Co requisites include Counter Terrorism and National Security Law.
- Note 39:* Only open to students who applied for and were selected for this clinic or externship.
- Note 40:* Students may register for an additional independent research credit to satisfy the College of Law Writing Requirement. All students are required to satisfy all other course requirements.
- Note 41:* All executive board members and senior staff members of Impunity Watch will receive 2 pass/fail credits in the 3L year, subject to completion of membership/leadership requirements and approval by the Executive Board and faculty supervisor. All other staff will receive 1 pass/fail credit in the 3L year, subject to completion of membership requirements and approval by the Executive Board and faculty supervisor.
- Note 42:* Students can choose either to (i) write a research paper that meets the writing requirement; or (ii) write a series of shorter papers that do not satisfy the writing requirement. Other course requirements will need to be fulfilled regardless of writing option selected by student.
- Note 43:* Only open to students who have completed the basic clinic course in this specialty area. Enrollment is at the discretion of faculty member, and is very limited. Variable credits between 1 and 4, as determined by faculty instructor before the start of the semester. Clinic and externship credits, excluding the externship seminar, may not exceed a total of 20 during law school.
