COURSE NOTES

- Note 1:* New or Revised Course - see description for detailed information.
- Note 2:* Limited enrollment offering; may be dropped only during first 5 days of semester.
- Note 3:* Required for graduation. Professional Responsibility must be taken during second year.
- Note 4:* Total of 3 hours of credit; may register for either 2 hours Fall and 1 hour Spring or 1 hour Fall and 2 hours Spring; must enroll both semesters.
- Note 5:* This is a one semester clinic. Students must register for 6 credits. Clinic and externship credits, excluding the externship seminar, may not exceed a total of 20 during law school.
- Note 6:* 2 hours Fall, 2 hours Spring; must enroll both semesters; will receive a grade at end of each semester. **This is a NO DROP course offering.**
- Note 7:* Senior editors may earn 3 credits (2 hours in Fall and 1 hour in Spring or 1 hour in Fall and 2 hours in Spring); other third year student editors may earn 2 credits by registering for 1 hour each semester or 2 hours in either the Fall or Spring semester.
- Note 8:* Students eligible to receive 2 hours of credit for academic year may register for 1 hour of credit each semester or 2 hours of credit in either Fall or Spring.
- Note 9:* 1 hour Fall, 1 hour Spring; must register both semester.
- Note 10:* 3 hours Fall, 3 hours Spring; must enroll both semesters; will receive grade at the end of academic year.
- Note 11:* All Associate Moot Court Board members must register for this course. Fall course sections are open to Moot Court Students only.
- Note 12:* Does not meet writing requirement.
- Note 13:* The seven directors only will receive 2 credits.
- Note 14:* International Law is required for members of the Journal of International Law and Commerce.
- Note 15:* Students who register for Family Law Pro Bono Services course must also register for the one credit pass/fail placement section.
- Note 16:* See instructor for explanation of credit hours and attendance policy.
- Note 17:* 6 hours Fall, 6 hours Spring; must enroll both semesters. Clinic and externship credits, excluding the externship seminar, may not exceed a total of 20 during law school.
- Note 18:* No-Drop limited enrollment offering. Students are not permitted to drop course at any time after the last day of the Fall or Spring registration period.
- Note 19:* Course may be taken with the Pass/Fail grading option. See Academic Rule J(3-5).
- Note 20:* The Bankruptcy Clinic is a full year one credit course. Students are to register for 0 credit in the Fall Semester and 1 credit in the Spring; will receive grade at the end of academic year. The class will meet every other week for fifty minutes beginning Wednesday, August 31. Clinic and externship credits (excluding the externship seminar) may not exceed 20 total credits. This is a NO-DROP limited enrollment course offering and may not be dropped any time without permission from the instructor.
- Note 21:* Enrollment in Lawyer as Negotiator requires permission of instructor; special registration procedures apply. This is a NO-DROP course offering and may not be dropped at any time without permission from the instructor.
- Note 22:* Course offering contingent upon faculty approval.
- Note 23:* Course designated to meet writing requirement.
- Note 24:* Research Center and Special Programs Course - two semester course; must enroll both semesters. Students will receive final grade at end of academic year.
- Note 25:* Continuation of Con. Law I; requirement for graduation. Must be taken in the fall semester of second year unless a petition is approved in advance by the Senior Assistant Dean for Student Life.
- Note 26:* N/A
- Note 27:* Only open to students who applied for and were selected for this clinic or externship.
- Note 28:* N/A
- Note 29:* Seminar is for one semester only.
- Note 30:* Clinic and externship students may register for up to 20 credits in clinics and externships, excluding the externship seminar, during law school. Students who have not previously taken a clinic or externship will be given priority in registration over students who have previously enrolled in a clinic or externship.
- Note 31:* N/A
- Note 32:* One semester clinic, seminar, or a Research Center and Special Programs course.
- Note 33:* Only open to students who have completed the basic clinic course in this specialty area. Enrollment is at the discretion of faculty member, and is very limited. Variable credits between 1 and 4, as determined by faculty instructor before the start of the semester. Clinic and externship credits, excluding the externship seminar, may not exceed a total of 20 during law school.
- Note 34:* This is an interdisciplinary course cross listed with SUNY Upstate Medical University and will be taught by SUNY/Med Professor Amy Campbell. Enrollment is limited to five law students. Students may elect to write a paper to satisfy the COL writing requirement. The first class begins Tuesday, August 30.
- Note 35:* Students may earn two hours of fully graded credit for independent research under faculty supervision. Satisfactory completion of a two credit independent research project may satisfy the writing requirement for graduation provided that the project satisfies the requirements of Academic Rule A(3)(b).
- Note 36:* Cross listed with PPA-730.
- Note 37:* Course is exempt from upper class grading curve.
- Note 38:* All students must enroll in a two credit graded externship seminar class that will meet during the designated class time. Externs also are required to work 8 hours/week at a placement to receive two additional placement credits and 12 hours to receive three additional placement credits.
- Note 39:* Graded Pass/Fail only.
- Note 40:* This is a 2 credit course; students may register for an additional credit to satisfy the College of Law Writing Requirement. All students are required to satisfy all other course requirements.
- Note 41:* All executive board members and senior staff members of Impunity Watch will receive 2 pass/fail credits in the 3L year, subject to completion of membership/leadership requirements and approval by the Executive Board and faculty supervisor. All other staff will receive 1 pass/fail credit in the 3L year, subject to completion of membership requirements and approval by the Executive Board and faculty supervisor.
- Note 42:* Students who earn 2 credits may register for 2 credits in either the Fall or Spring Semester or 1 credit hour each semester for a total of 2 credits. Students who earn 1 credit may register for 1 credit hour either in the Fall or Spring.
