## COURSE NOTES

- Note 1:* ARR designates that days and times for this summer semester class will be arranged by the professor. Students should check with professor for days and times prior to first day of classes.
- Note 2:* Independent Research - Students may earn two hours of fully graded credits by registering for one hour in Spring/Summer or Summer/Fall; must register both semesters. Satisfactory completion of a two credit independent research project may satisfy the writing requirement for graduation provided that the project satisfies the requirements of Academic Rule A(3)(b).
- Note 3:* Limited Enrollment Course.
- Note 4:* Note for all clinic and externship students: Students may register for a maximum of 20 credits in clinics (excluding the externship seminar) during law school.
- Note 5:* This is a one-week course scheduled for Monday May 23 thru Friday May 27.
- Note 6:* Application required. Copies of application are available at the Office of Clinical Legal Education, Room 306.
- Note 7:* All summer clinic and externship students must have completed one full year of law school and be students in good academic standing. Additional information may be obtained from the Office of Clinical Legal Education, Room 306.
- Note 8:* All Summer Away Externships are graded on a pass/fail basis.
- Note 9:* The College of Law will offer academic credit to students who secure externship positions outside of Syracuse as part of its Summer Away Externship Program. The Summer Away Externship positions must be approved by the Externship Coordinator prior to enrollment. Students who successfully complete the application and course requirements may receive 3 summer credits. The Summer Away Externship Program includes an academic component, including a weekly journal.
- Note 10:* New or revised course – see description for detailed information.
- Note 11:* Course exempt from upperclass grading curve.
- Note 12:* Graduation requirement, must be taken in second year.
- Note 13:* May be taken using the Pass/Fail option not to exceed 7 total Pass/Fail credits according to academic rules.

### **NOTE TO ALL STUDENTS:**

Students enrolled in the College of Law Summer Semester must carry 6 credits for full-time status (to earn 1/2 unit of residence) and 4 credits for part-time status (to earn 3/8 unit of residence).
