Judge Paris presides in the NYS Supreme Court. Typical tasks include legal research and writing; review of motions and preparation of bench memoranda for the Court; performing research on evidentiary and other legal issues; trial observation and necessary research on trial issues including preparation of jury instructions. Judge Paris is also be assigned to the general civil trial part and hears many types of civil matters such as negligence, malpractice, contracts, corporations etc. as well as mental hygiene cases and other civil issues.
